COMPETITION DETAILS SUMMARY

Games

Wednesday Night: Timeslots are 6.30pm, 7.30pm & 8.30pm (depending on number of entries). Game duration is 4 x 12 minute quarters, with 2 minute breaks.

A regrade may take place during the comp, depending on performance or team changes.

Saturday Morning: Timeslot is 9.00am. Game duration is 4 x 15 minute quarters, with 2 minute breaks.

Both comps: Players must be 15yrs age minimum, unless approved by Executive (see Policy)

Mixed games

Male players – There must be a minimum of 1 and a maximum of 3 on court per team. Each male must cover one of the following positions to remain spread across all 3 thirds. One for GS/GA, one for GK/GD, one for WD/C/WA. Note that if your Mixed team has players from multiple ladies teams, only one ladies team will be considered in game time fixtures.

Fill in players

NOT allowed, only registered players from your own team can go on court. Doing so will incur a penalty – your team will have to forfeit the game.

Uniforms

Team players to wear the same colour and style of t-shirt.

Umpires

Teams are encouraged to submit names to be included on the umpire roster. Contact 0450 707 635 for details.

Meeting

Next meeting date: TBC. One registered player from each club (or team) must attend, otherwise a \$50 fine applies. This fine must be paid before your next game.

Forfeits

You may only forfeit once in the competition, otherwise for each subsequent forfeit you will be fined \$40. This fine must be paid before your next game. After the second forfeit you will also lose an extra point.

At the Game

You must have at least 5 players to play the game, any less and you have to forfeit the game.

You have 5 minutes wait time for late arrivals to make your 5 players, before you have to forfeit.

The team who receives the forfeit is allocated 3 points.

The team who gives the forfeit receives no points.

Before the Game

If you wish to forfeit before game time, this **MUST** be done before 10am (Wed comp) or 8am (Sat comp) on the day of play. To do this, notify Suzanne on 0450 707 635 as soon as you can, so the other team can be advised and save them coming out unnecessarily.

The team who receives the forfeit is allocated 3 points.

The team who gives the forfeit receives no points (see NOTE below)

NOTE:

Failing to notify before the above times on the day of play is classed as “forfeiting without notice” and the team who failed to give notice will have an extra point deducted.

The team who receives the forfeit is allocated 3 points.

The team who gives the forfeit receives a **MINUS POINT**.

Forfeiting during the Finals

If you forfeit during the Finals, your team will be eliminated.

Results

Are updated to the Website normally by Thursday afternoon for the Wednesday Night competition and by Saturday afternoon for the Saturday Competition, so check for the latest info after that.

Points

Points are allocated as such: Win = 3, Loss = 1, Bye = 2, Wet weather cancellation = 2, Forfeit received = 3, Forfeit given = 0 and Forfeit without notification = minus 1.

Finals

Players must have played 3 games with your team to be eligible to play in the Finals games.

If an ineligible player plays, your team will be eliminated.

If you forfeit during the Finals your team will be eliminated.

Wet Weather

If games are cancelled due to wet weather your team contact will be notified, and all teams receive 2 points.

Games from the round are not re-scheduled for play.

If games go ahead but at 6.30 the night is cancelled, all teams receive 2 points.

If games go ahead and one timeslot is played but the others are cancelled, all teams receive 2 points regardless of play.

If the first Finals game is cancelled teams will progress as Winner/Loser as per their incoming points/goal average.

If a subsequent Finals game is cancelled, that game will be played the following week and all following games will be extended by one week.

Please note that if the situation allows, we will play shortened games on the indoor courts.

Kiosk

Is open during competition. You can borrow balls and position tags or purchase whistles, drinks and sweets.

Hot food is instant noodles or soup, with tea/coffee/hot chocolate available (coffee machine). Dispensing machines are also available and located in front of the kiosk.

Dates of competition

Wednesday night comp: 21 February 2024 – 19 June 2024 (includes Finals games)

There will be a Prize Award presentation to Winners/Runners Up of each grade.
